
IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF NEWLY FILED DOMESTIC CASES TO CERTAIN DESIGNATED  
KANSAS CITY CIRCUIT DIVISIONS BEGINNING JANUARY 3, 2017

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2016 – 207

Pursuant to Paragraph 2, Section 478.240 R.S.Mo. and applicable local rules; and in order to facilitate the provisions of the 2017 Assignment Order (Administrative Order No. 2016-096), which provides that all Kansas City circuit trial divisions shall convert to a combined civil, criminal, and domestic docket beginning July 1, 2017; it is hereby ordered that:

1. The Department of Civil Records shall begin assigning newly filed contested domestic cases to Divisions 1, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, and 18 on January 3, 2017.
2. The Department of Civil Records shall no longer assign any newly filed contested domestic cases to Divisions 8 and 15 beginning on January 3, 2017.
3. The cases eligible for assignment to the divisions set forth in paragraph 1 shall include any and all contested domestic cases filed in the Kansas City location on or after January 1, 2017.
4. Such assignment is intended to provide an inventory of newly filed contested domestic cases to the divisions, set forth in paragraph 1, moving to a combined docket that includes domestic cases, which may later be supplemented by existing cases transferred from the divisions, set forth in paragraph 2, transferring from an exclusive domestic assignment to a combined docket, effective July 1, 2017.
5. Such assignment of newly filed contested domestic cases shall continue until further order of this Court.
