ORDER

Pursuant to Court Operating Rule 27.01, the Missouri Court Automation Committee has determined that:

Effective March 4, 2013, all civil and domestic relations filings with the Jackson County Circuit Court at the Independence Courthouse, whether on new or existing cases, except for Orders of Protection, and those filed by self-represented parties, shall be filed electronically, and

Effective March 25, 2013, all civil and domestic relations filings, including those filed with the Jackson County Circuit Court at the Kansas City Courthouse, whether on new or existing cases, except for Orders of Protection, and those filed by self-represented parties, shall be filed electronically.


All new case filings and all subsequent filings filed by attorneys in existing cases in the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, as described above, whether or not originally filed electronically, shall be electronically filed. Such filings shall be made as provided in Rule 103 and Court Operating Rule 27, copies of which can

be accessed at <http://www.courts.mo.gov/efilingrules>. Local information regarding eFiling is available at www.16thcircuit.org/efiling-information.

All civil and domestic relations filings at the Family Justice Center shall continue to be filed in paper form until further notice.

The Court Administrator's office shall notify all known bar associations in the county of this Order as well as any other persons the Court Administrator's office deems appropriate and shall assist those making such filings. The Court Administrator's office also shall report any problems to the OSCA Help Desk.
