IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Cases shall be scheduled for trial by the Circuit Judges in accordance with the attached 12-week cycle schedules. The schedules may be deviated from only in accordance with local rule 6.2, or as required to efficiently manage the cases assigned to the judicial officer responsible for handling the cases.
- 2. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 25, 27, and 29 shall hear Municipal Trials de Novo filed at Kansas City on a rotating schedule prepared by the Director of Criminal Records. The Associate Circuit Judge of Division 28 shall hear Municipal Trials de Novo filed at Independence.
- 3. Driver cases, as referred to herein, shall include Petitions for Trial de Novo from Administrative Revocations or Suspensions, Application for Hardship Driving Privilege, Applications for Hearing on Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test, and Petitions for Review. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 25, 27, and 29 shall hear such cases filed at Kansas City on a rotating schedule prepared by the Director of Civil Records. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 30 and 32 shall hear such cases filed at Independence.
- 4. In accordance with Paragraph 1, Section 478.072 R.S.Mo., all Associate Circuit Judge uncontested civil matters in which the petition requests damages exceeding \$5000 shall be on the record and preserved by utilizing electronic, magnetic, mechanical sound, or video recording devices.
- 5. In accordance with Paragraph 1, Section 478.072 R.S.Mo., all Associate Circuit Judge contested civil matters, regardless of the amount of damages claimed, shall be on the record and preserved by utilizing electronic, magnetic, mechanical sound, or video recording devices.
- 6. All Judges of the Circuit Court shall rotate evening, weekend, and holiday on-call duty to review domestic violence orders of protection and criminal matters pursuant to a weekly schedule established by administrative order.
- 7. The Family Court Commissioners shall rotate evening, weekend, and holiday on-call duty to review orders pursuant to Chapter 211 R.S.Mo. pursuant to a weekly schedule established by administrative order.
- 8. Cases will be assigned to visiting judges from the circuits designated to assist with the dockets in Jackson County, and to other visiting judges, as directed by the Presiding Judge.
