ATTENTION – TERMINATION OF CHILD SUPPORT

The following instructions for the completion of Form 14 – Calculation of Child Support Worksheet should be followed for Termination of Child Support only.

The following information on the Form 14 Child Support Worksheet must be completed if the amount of child support to be paid for the remaining children is to be modified:

- #1 Provide you <u>monthly gross income</u> (Income before taxes). If you know the other parents monthly gross income that will be helpful but it is not necessary.
- # 2 (b) Monthly cost of child care/daycare
- # 3 (c) Monthly <u>health insurance cost</u> for the children

YOU DO NOT HAVE TO COMPLETE THE OTHER BOXES OR CALCULATE THE AMOUNT OF CHILD SUPPORT TO BE PAID WHEN USING THIS FORM WITH A TERMINATION OF CHILD SUPPORT. The Judge/Commissioner will complete the Child Support Worksheet based on the information you provide.

* Form 14 is required to be completed for Dissolution of Marriage, Paternity, Modifications, etc. or your case will be delayed. The court staff and Judges will not complete Form 14 when filing any case other than a Termination of Child Support. As such, these instructions do not apply to Dissolution of Marriage, Paternity Actions, Modifications, or any other type of domestic filing, except a Termination of Child Support.
