## COURTROOM GUIDELINES – USE OF SOUND SYSTEM AT TRIAL IN DIVISION 28

Division 28 has installed a sound system designed to assist parties, witnesses and counsel in presenting evidence and arguments in a trial. It is the responsibility of counsel to use this sound system to conduct trial.

- 1. Each attorney should contact the bailiff/law clerk before trial begins to obtain the lapel microphone equipment and for any required instruction on the use of the system.
- 2. Each attorney should advise respective witnesses whom they intend to call during the course of trial of the need to speak into the microphone when testifying.
- 3. The Court has a master switch that will mute the sound system during all bench conferences during trial.
- 4. It is the responsibility of counsel to advise the Court if the battery is low on their respective lapel microphones. If a battery needs to be replaced, please notify the bailiff/law clerk.
