

## **NOTICE**

### **TO ALL ATTORNEYS RESIDING IN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI**

The Kansas City, Missouri Municipal Judicial Nominating Commission of the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit of Missouri announces the solicitation of nominees for the office of Municipal Judge, Division 202, of the Kansas City Municipal Division, 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit of Missouri. Any attorney residing in Kansas City, Missouri may indicate his/her willingness to serve and be considered for nomination to fill this position or may otherwise be nominated. Potential nominees must meet the following qualifications as set forth in Section 306 of the Charter of Kansas City, Missouri:

Municipal court judges shall be citizens of the United States and of the State of Missouri for five (5) years, residents of the City of Kansas City, Missouri for one (1) year, licensed to practice law in the state for at least five (5) years, members of the Missouri Bar in good standing, be less than seventy (70) years of age, and possess any additional qualifications prescribed by law.

Applications and instructions are available on the website for the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit (Jackson County), <http://www.16thcircuit.org> and are also available at the Office of the Court Administrator for the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit. The Office of the Court Administrator is temporarily located at the Novel Building, 405 E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Fourth Floor, Suite 400A, Kansas City, MO 64106 (this building is located directly south of the Jackson County Courthouse).

**The Commission must receive all completed applications for the municipal judge vacancy on or before 4:00 PM, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2019. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered by the Commission.**

The Commission will meet in the Division 3 courtroom, located on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Jackson County Courthouse, 415 E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, Missouri, on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 starting at 9:30 AM to conduct public interviews of the applicants. The Commission will then select a panel of three nominees for the vacancy. Thereafter, the City Council for the City of Kansas City, Missouri will select the judge of Division 202.
