
ORDER

Now, on this 22nd day of June, 2011, when a juvenile is presented at the Jackson County Juvenile Detention Facility for delinquent acts, it is hereby ordered that the Juvenile Officer may, pursuant to Sections 211.141 and 211.151 RSMo., detain juveniles in judicial custody, at the Jackson House or any other similar facility operated by or contracted for by the Deputy Court Administrator/Family Court for that purpose, when the juvenile's detention risk assessment indicates that such placement is appropriate as an alternative to secure detention.

In addition, as provided by Sections 211.141 and 211.401 RSMo., and Rule 127.02, the Juvenile Officer may release a juvenile to his/her parent, guardian or legal custodian under such conditions as may be necessary to assure the juvenile's attendance at future court hearings and to minimize the likelihood of new offenses prior to adjudication. Conditional release may include, but not be limited to, the use of home detention with or without monitoring including electronic monitoring as necessary, day and evening reporting centers, directions to avoid contact with victims or other persons as deemed appropriate. Each conditional release shall expire by operation of law within 24 hours of said release unless a petition or motion to modify has been filed and an ex parte order of detention has been obtained to continue such conditional release. The Juvenile Officer shall only conditionally release juveniles under this order when the juvenile's detention risk assessment indicates that such placement is appropriate as an alternative to secure detention.

It is further ordered that Administrative Order 07-03 is set aside and held for naught.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
