ORDER OF COURT FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CUSTODY HEARING

The Court takes judicial notice of the contents of its own file(s) and upon considering the information and evidence presented at this hearing finds:

- It is necessary for the juvenile to remain in protective custody.
- It is not necessary for the juvenile to remain in protective custody.
- The first contact with the juvenile's family occurred during an emergency in which the juvenile could not safely remain at home and continuation of the juvenile in the home was contrary to the welfare of the juvenile. Therefore it was reasonable to remove the juvenile due to emergency circumstances.
- Reasonable efforts were made to keep the juvenile in the home but continuation of the juvenile in the home is contrary to the welfare of the juvenile.
- Reasonable efforts to prevent removal from the home were not made, but reasonable efforts are now being made to return the juvenile to the home. Continuation of the juvenile in the home is contrary to the welfare of the juvenile.

Accordingly, the Court enters the following order:

- Until further order of the Court, the juvenile is to remain in protective custody and in the temporary legal custody of:
 - Children's Division _____
 - Other: _____, under the supervision of the Children's Division.
- If the juvenile fails to remain in the court ordered placement or to comply with the rules of placement or supervision, the juvenile may be subject to secure detention.**
- The juvenile is ordered released forthwith to:

 - Capias to be issued for juvenile as parent(s) have failed to produce child for hearing.

Visitation:

Paternity:

- The Court orders that the CD immediately begin proceedings to determine the paternity of this child.

- The mother is hereby ordered to disclose to the CD and the Juvenile Officer the name and current addresses of all potential fathers of this child. Such disclosure shall be submitted in writing to the CD and the Juvenile Officer within 10 days of this order.

Support:

- The Court has advised the child's legal custodians of their obligation to provide financial support for the child while the child is not in their custody.
- Parents and legal custodians are hereby ordered to appear with completed Form 14 prior to the disposition of this case.

Attorney Appointments:

- The Court has informed the parties appearing this date, in open court, that they are required to cooperate with counsel and that failure to cooperate with counsel may result in the Court permitting the attorney to withdraw from the case. In such situations, the parents may have to represent themselves without the assistance of attorneys.

Other Orders:

Upon agreement of the parents and /or custodians, and as otherwise required for the welfare of the child, it is hereby ordered that the CD shall immediately arrange for and the party shall participate in:

- Psychological evaluation of: Mother Father Custodian Juvenile
- Psychiatric evaluation of: Mother Father Custodian Juvenile
- Substance abuse screening/evaluation of: Mother Father Custodian Juvenile
- Individual therapy for: Mother Father Custodian Juvenile
