Appointed Guardians ad litem shall be familiar with, and fully comply with, the current Administrative Orders governing adoption procedures and Guardian ad litem standards/training.

In every cause not docketed within thirty days of filing, Petitioners' counsel shall, prior to the end of such thirty day period, request that Family Court Records appoint a guardian who shall be appointed at random from the list of guardians in this Order.

Further, when the Court grants a request for a special setting for temporary adoption, or other special setting, in a non-211 case, Petitioners shall request that Family Court Records appoint a guardian from this list.

It is ordered that Administrative Order 18-05 be set aside and held for naught.
