ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-035

ORDER

WHEREAS, the existence and spread of the COVID-19 virus resulted in a world-wide pandemic; and

WHEREAS, it has been and remains imperative to take steps to protect the health and safety of the public as well as all employees of the 16th Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and necessary to continue to take action to reduce the exposure and spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the unprecedented circumstances existing at this time warrant this administrative action; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Orders 2020-063, 2020-121, and 2020-192 were previously entered to address the issue addressed by this Administrative Order. Administrative Order 2020-192 superseded Administrative Order 2020-121. The prior Administrative Orders stated that they were subject to review or modification; and

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the 16th Judicial Circuit has general administrative authority over the Circuit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that, effective immediately, Administrative Order 2020-192 is superseded by this Administrative Order as set forth below.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for all defendants in the 16th Judicial Circuit who have been sentenced to a term of commitment in the Jackson County Detention Center ("JCDC") seven consecutive days or less but who have not yet reported to the JCDC, the surrender date for the defendant to report to the JCDC shall be as follows:

1. If the original surrender date (or the date the defendant was ordered to report) to the JCDC was any day in the months of March, April, May or June 2020, any such defendant should have already surrendered/reported to JCDC prior to the date of this Administrative Order. If any such defendant did not report as Ordered and scheduled, said defendant will be subject to further action by the Court as deemed appropriate by the assigned judicial officer.

2. If the original surrender date (or the date the defendant is/was ordered to report) to the JCDC is/was any day in July 2020, that surrender/report date shall be stayed and the defendant shall have surrendered/reported to the JCDC on November 13, 2020.

3. If the original surrender date (or the date the defendant is ordered to report) to the JCDC is any day starting in August, September, October or November 2020, that surrender/report date shall be deemed stayed and the defendant shall surrender/report to JCDC on the date that is 120 days after the original ordered surrender/report date.

4. If the original surrender date (or the date the defendant is ordered to report) to the JCDC is any day starting December 1, 2020 or later, that surrender/report date shall be stayed and the defendant shall surrender/report to the JCDC on the date that is 120 days after the original ordered surrender/report date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order applies to standard incarceration sentences of seven consecutive days or less and orders of "shock time" incarceration of seven consecutive days or less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order will remain in effect until the end of the day on July 12, 2021, unless modified, amended or extended.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
