FAMILY COURT CASES

CASE MANAGEMENT:

- Case management statements shall be filed seven (7) days prior to the case management date.
- Attorneys and their clients shall appear for the case management hearing.
- The parties shall be prepared to advise the court of the issues remaining for trial.
- The parties shall be prepared to discuss mediation.
- The parties shall be prepared to set the matter for trial.
- All trial dates are special settings and therefore continuances will not be freely granted.
- Failure to appear for case management may result in dismissal of the case.

TRIAL:

- All parties shall provide the court reporter with a **witness and exhibit list** in the format provided on this website on the day of trial. The parties shall contact the court reporter before trial to discuss numbering the exhibits. (see 'Forms' section)
- **Proposed judgments and/or orders** shall be e-mailed to the division law clerk after trial but no later than five (5) days from the trial date.
- The parties shall dress appropriately for court. (Local Rule 9.4)
