Please be advised that any hearings, docket calls, or case management conferences scheduled with Judge Janette Rodecap will be held in **Division 29 on the 7th Floor of the Jackson County Courthouse, 415 E. 12th Street, Kansas City, MO 64106**. You may appear for your hearing: (1) in person; (2) by telephone or (3) by videoconferencing.

To appear **IN PERSON**, please arrive early and bring your own <u>MASK</u>, because masks are <u>**REQUIRED**</u> to enter the Courthouse. You may experience long wait times to enter the Courthouse and to get on an elevator. Only counsel and named litigants will be allowed into the Courtroom. All individuals will be expected to follow social distancing requirements by maintaining a six foot distance between themselves and any other individual. Individuals who are not following social distancing requirements may be removed from the Courtroom.

To participate by **TELEPHONE**, you must **CALL IN** using the following **TOLL-FREE NUMBER: 844-487-0491**, enter the **MEETING NUMBER: 963 210 507**, and press # to join without entering an attendee ID number. You will either join the live docket or be placed in the waiting room until Judge Rodecap or her staff admits you. The Court has many cases to call on each docket, so please be available to stay on the phone for at least an hour after the docket starts. After your case has been called, you can hang up your phone to disconnect from the docket.
