## **ORDER**

Pursuant to Court Operating Rule 27.01, the Missouri Court Automation Committee has determined that:

Effective September 9, 2013, all probate filings in the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, Circuit Court of Jackson County, whether on new or existing cases, shall be filed electronically, with the following exceptions:

- 1) cases filed by agencies in civil commitment matters (exclusive of cases filed pursuant to R.S.Mo. § 632.480-513), and
  - 2) matters filed by non-attorney self-represented parties.

Such filings shall be made as provided in Supreme Court Rule 103 and Supreme Court Operating Rule 27, copies of which can be accessed at <a href="http://www.courts.mo.gov/efilingrules">http://www.courts.mo.gov/efilingrules</a>. The Court Administrator's office shall notify all known bar associations in Jackson County of this Order as well as any other persons the Court Administrator's office deems
