I shall abide by the following Conditions of Supervision that address Community Protection, Offender Accountability, and Competency Development. I shall:

Community Protection Conditions:

- 1) Abide by the laws of the State of Missouri, federal statutes, municipal ordinances, and the laws of any state.
2) Advise the assigned Officer IMMEDIATELY of any change or proposed change in address or telephone number.
3) Not possess or employ firearms, weapons, or other instruments of potential harm to others or self.
4) Follow parental directions and expectations, leave home with permission and abide by the Curfew: Sunday through Thursday _____ PM, and Friday & Saturday _____ PM.
5) Abide by the court order when it forbids contact with the victim. My Officer shall specifically instruct me when contact is authorized.
6) Associate only with others that have been approved by parents and the assigned Officer.
7) Have no contact with others having a criminal history or who possess drugs or weapons, or who have gang affiliations.

Accountability Conditions:

- 1) Report to the assigned Officer as directed and receive Family Court personnel monitoring checks at any time.
2) Notify the assigned Officer within 48 hours of being questioned or arrested by a law enforcement officer.
3) Not possess or consume alcohol or any non-prescribed or illegal drug.
4) Submit to drug urinalysis testing as directed, understanding that refusal will be reported as positive use of illegal substance.
5) Submit to a search by the assigned Officer as directed.
6) Fulfill the Court ordered restitution obligation.
