News Release

On June 12, 2024, the Administrative Judge of the Jackson County Family Court issued a ruling related to one of the juveniles that was alleged to be involved in the shooting that occurred at the Chiefs rally and parade on February 14, 2024. After hearing the evidence that was presented by the Jackson County Juvenile Officer and the Juvenile's attorneys relating to certification, the Administrative Judge determined the Juvenile was a proper subject to be dealt with under the provisions of the Missouri juvenile justice system. As such, the Court did not certify the Juvenile to stand trial as an adult, and the matter will continue to be heard in the Jackson County Family Court. Missouri law requires the names of juveniles to be confidential when their cases are in the juvenile justice system in the Family Court Division.
