The Kansas City, Missouri Municipal Judicial Nominating Commission of the 16th Judicial Circuit of Missouri announces the solicitation of nominees for the offices of Municipal Judge, Divisions 204 and 205, of the Kansas City Municipal Division, 16th Judicial Circuit of Missouri. Any attorney residing in Kansas City, Missouri may indicate his/her willingness to serve and be considered for nomination to fill these positions or may otherwise be nominated.

Potential nominees must meet the following qualifications as set forth in Section 306 of the Charter of Kansas City, Missouri:

- (a) *Citizenship*. Citizen of the United States and the State of Missouri for five years immediately prior to appointment;
- (b) Residency. Resident of the City of Kansas City, Missouri for one year immediately prior to appointment and continuously during service as a judge;
- (c) Licensed to practice law. Licensed to practice law in the State of Missouri for five years immediately prior to appointment;
- (d) *Member of The Missouri Bar*. Member of the Missouri Bar in good standing continuously during service as a judge;
- (e) Age. Be less than seventy years of age; and
- (f) Other qualifications. Possess any additional qualifications prescribed by law.

The Commission must receive all completed applications for *both* municipal judge vacancies on or before 4:00 PM, November 14, 2022. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered by the Commission.

The Commission will meet in the Division 6 courtroom, located on the 6th floor of the Jackson County Courthouse, 415 E. 12th Street, Kansas City, Missouri, on November 21, 2022 starting at 8:30 AM to conduct public interviews of the applicants for the vacancies in BOTH Divisions. The Commission will then select a panel of three nominees for the vacancy in Division 205 only. Thereafter, the City Council for the City of Kansas City, Missouri will select the judge of Division 205. The Commission anticipates that it will meet at a later date—without further interviews—to select a panel of nominees for the vacancy in Division 204.
