## **ORDER**

Now on this <u>23rd</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2024:

Whereas, the Court recognizes, due to the gradual closure of the Office of Guardian ad Litem (OGAL), Guardian ad Litems (GALs) employed within OGAL may need to transfer cases to GALs outside of OGAL, and

Whereas, the Court recognizes that during the transfer of said cases to outside GALs, it may become necessary to transfer relevant physical and electronic files created or possessed by OGAL to the outside GALs to effectuate the representation of juvenile(s') interests, and

Whereas, the Court recognizes that the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel has informed OGAL during an informal advisory opinion that case files, including past cases, may be transferred to newly appointed outside GALs upon court order,

**Therefore**, it is hereby ordered that, effective May 28th, 2024, the Acting Director of the Office of the Guardian ad Litem (OGAL), or their successor, shall be authorized to transfer the relevant physical and electronic files of juveniles being represented by OGAL to newly appointed outside GALs without further order from this Court. Such transfers may occur provided: it is a case where OGAL is currently appointed to represent the interests of the juvenile(s), the outside GAL has agreed to represent the interest of the juvenile(s) and has entered their appearance as GAL, and OGAL has received permission from the assigned Judicial Officer to withdraw as GAL in the case.
