IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Cases shall be scheduled for trial by the Circuit Judges in accordance with the attached 12-week cycle schedules. The schedules may be deviated from only in accordance with local rule 6.2.
- 2. Notwithstanding the changes in assignment scheduled to take place on July 1 2008, cases on the Civil and Criminal dockets assigned to Divisions 11 and 18, which currently have a trial setting in calendar year 2008, shall remain assigned to such divisions.
- 3. Notwithstanding the changes in assignment scheduled to take place on July 1 2008, cases on the Family Court Domestic Relations dockets currently assigned to divisions located in Kansas City shall remain assigned to such divisions unless otherwise ordered. Such cases shall continue to be scheduled for trial during the divisions' remaining 2008 domestic relations weeks as set forth in the attached 12-week cycles or, at the discretion of the judges of those divisions, during those weeks, or portions thereof, that such divisions are not scheduled to hear other dockets.
- 4. Cases on the Circuit Civil and Family Court Domestic Relations dockets currently assigned to Division 28 shall remain assigned to Division 28 and shall be scheduled for trial at the discretion of the Associate Circuit Judge of Division 28 during those weeks, or portions thereof, that Division 28 is not assigned to hear other dockets.
- 5. The Associate Circuit Judge of Division 28 shall, without further order, accept transfers of civil and/or criminal cases from Divisions 30, 32, and 33 for the purpose of conducting jury trials disposing of such cases and shall schedule such cases for trial during those weeks, or portions thereof, that Division 28 is not assigned to hear other dockets.
- 6. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 25, 26, 27, and 29 shall hear Municipal Trials de Novo filed at Kansas City on a rotating schedule prepared by the Director of Criminal Records, except that the division assigned to Criminal ACJ shall not be included in the rotation during the period so assigned. The Associate Circuit Judge of Division 28 shall hear Municipal Trials de Novo filed at Independence.
- 7. Driver cases, as referred to herein, shall include Petitions for Trial de Novo from Administrative Revocations or Suspensions, Application for Hardship Driving Privilege, Applications for Hearing on Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test, and Petitions for Review. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 25, 26, 27, and 29 shall hear such cases filed at Kansas City on a rotating schedule prepared by the Director of Civil Records, except that the division assigned to Criminal ACJ shall not be included in the rotation during the period so assigned. The Associate Circuit Judges of Divisions 30 and 32 shall hear such cases filed at Independence.

- 8. In accordance with Paragraph 1, Section 478.072 R.S.Mo., all Associate Circuit Judge uncontested civil matters in which the petition requests damages exceeding \$5000 shall be on the record and preserved by utilizing electronic, magnetic, mechanical sound, or video recording devices.
- 9. In accordance with Paragraph 1, Section 478.072 R.S.Mo., all Associate Circuit Judge contested civil matters, regardless of the amount of damages claimed, shall be on the record and preserved by utilizing electronic, magnetic, mechanical sound, or video recording devices.
- 10. All Judges of the Circuit Court shall rotate evening, weekend, and holiday on-call duty to review domestic violence orders of protection and criminal matters pursuant to a weekly schedule established by administrative order.
- 11. The Family Court Commissioners shall rotate evening, weekend, and holiday oncall duty to review orders pursuant to Chapter 211 R.S.Mo. pursuant to a weekly schedule established by administrative order.
