POLICY:

The Office of the Guardian ad Litem (OGAL) shall protect the interest of a child who is a witness in a proceeding in which OGAL has been appointed to represent said child and in ancillary cases to the extent allowed.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. The assigned Guardian ad Litem (GAL) attorney will be present at any conference/meeting/deposition between counsel for a party and the child.
- 2. The assigned GAL attorney will endeavor to prevent the child from participating in multiple depositions and repetitive examinations.
- 3. The assigned GAL attorney shall file any necessary Motion(s) for Protective Order(s) to protect the best interest of the client.
- 4. If the child must testify or undergo a deposition, the assigned GAL attorney shall meet with the child before the child testifies to explain the proceeding.
- 5. The assigned GAL attorney shall, to the extent possible, go over the questions that might be asked of the child prior to the deposition or trial testimony.
- 6. The assigned GAL attorney shall attempt to make the child familiar and comfortable with the courtroom.
