PURPOSE:

In order to promote and uphold the process of due process and fairness in juvenile court proceedings, the Office of the Guardian ad litem and the staff will not initiate or engage in ex parte communication with the juvenile judge outside the presence of the parties or their legal counsel concerning a pending matter before the judicial officer.

DEFINITIONS:

"Ex parte" is a Latin phrase meaning "on one side only; by or for one party." An ex parte communication occurs when a party to a case, or someone involved with a party, talks or writes to or otherwise communicates directly with the judicial officer about the issues in the case without the other parties' knowledge.

PROCEDURES:

The Office of the Guardian ad litem and the staff shall not engage in ex-parte communication with the juvenile judicial officer except in the circumstances of:

- 1. An emergency necessitating immediate notification to the court including, but not limited to, emergency medical and mental health needs of a juvenile, the death of a party or juvenile, unforeseen emergency situations concerning placement of a juvenile, and other critical circumstance where there are substantial safety concerns or issues that make an emergency notification prudent and necessary.
- 2. General scheduling purposes.
- 3. As expressly authorized by statute.

APPLICABILITY:

Policy 1030-27 – Ex Parte Communication Policy

The Office of the Guardian ad litem and Staff will abide by the Missouri Supreme Court Rule regarding Ex Parte Communication Rule 2-2-9.
